Job Description

The South Dakota Democratic Party (SDDP) is hiring four Campus Voter Registration Fellows for the 2022 cycle. We are looking for people who are passionate about registering new Democrats to vote and are willing to work on their host college campus. The SDDP recognizes the importance of increased Democratic voter registration and turnout, and we are hiring Fellows to make it a priority. There will be one Fellow each in Vermillion, Sioux Falls, Brookings, and Aberdeen.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Facilitate voter registration drives on campus and in the surrounding community
- Ensure each registration form is filled out correctly and succinctly
- Provide the Field Director with quantitative and qualitative reports as part of the ongoing evaluation of the program's success
- Hit metrics/goals for program elements, voter registration, and voter outreach
- Ensure accurate collection and data and drop off of all completed forms

Job Qualifications

Required

- Willingness to work on the campus you are assigned
- Must have access to a cell phone and laptop/computer
- Access to a vehicle or other reliable transportation
- A solutions-oriented and motivated mindset
- Comfortable with technology
- Ability to work irregular hours and weekends
- Attend college in person in one of the four towns we are hiring in

This is an entry-level position, and training will be provided upon starting.

This is a full-time position lasting through November 15, 2022. The pay for this position is \$13 per hour with a weekly work schedule of 10 hours.
